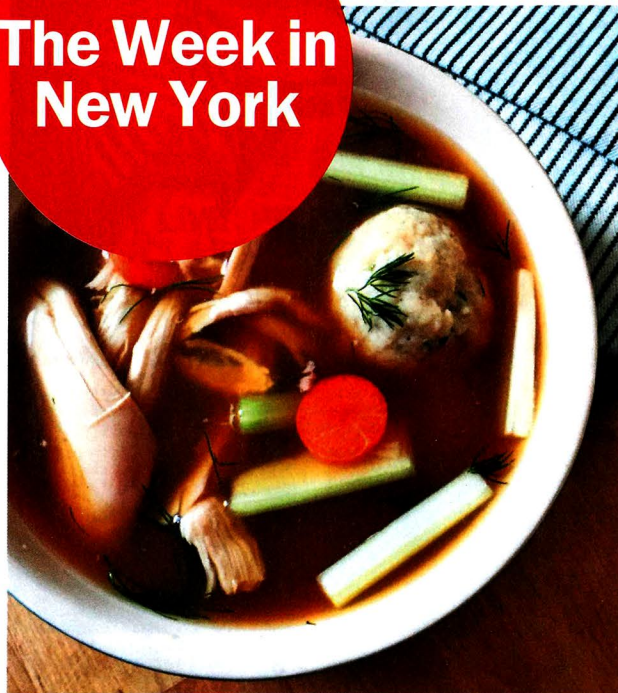

Let your people go (to a restaurant)

If anyone can prove gefilte fish is tasty, it's the city's top chefs. At Mile End Deli (646-494-9508, mileenddeli.com), a prix-fixe dinner on Friday 3 and Saturday 4 includes wine, smoked-chicken matzo-ball soup and lamb shoulder (\$125). Rosa Mexicano (rosamexicano.com) adds a Mexican twist on the same nights, with a charoset made of dates, coconuts and pomegranates, and banana-leaf-wrapped brisket (\$48).
